> Dear Bernard,
 >
 > My apologies for the delay in dispatching this letter regarding Mr Greg
 > Knight.
 >
 > A check of the files does not reveal any documented record of complaints
 > made against him. I have spoken to Mr Case who has advised that he could
 > not recall whether he had contacted referees in the appointment of Greg
 > Knight. There appears to be nine references included in his job
 > application for St Paul's School.
 >
 > Mr Case did advise me that there was a report indicating inappropriate
 > conduct at a School camp attended by Mr Knight which prompted his
 > resignation from the School on 29 October, 1984. ||| *clarify*
 >
 > The only information that may be of any use and is included in the Knight
 > file is the following:
 >
 > * a request made in December, 1983 to have the rooms where music
 > tuition was conducted, carpeted to reduce noise;
 > * a request in the same dispatch for students to be allowed to leave
 > class and visit teachers in the teacher's room for extra tuition. One
 > justification made by Mr knight for this suggestion is to offer the boys,
 > " alternative educational experiences".
 >
 > My understanding is that some time after Greg Night left St Paul's the
 > Northern Territory police made contact with the School to check if any
 > abuse occurred there during his employment. Mr Case may be better placed
 > to fill in the blanks here. ||| *more info*
 >
