Sirs,

It will eventually come to light that, despite your admirable efforts, the royal commission falls short of appropriately addressing the issue of abuse in two fundamental ways:

1. Justice McLellan's summary comments about the findings of the commission are equally attributable to the debilitating yet more widespread and invisible acts of emotional abuse
2. The main perpetrators of abuse are parents (primary carers) not institutions, although as with physical and sexual abuse, the social attitude of burying the issue is encouraged and perpetuated by inappropriate institutional responses.

We are currently developing a global documentary on Primary Carer Emotional Abuse and are interested in discussing our findings with the commission.
