

I was raped by [REDACTED] at Church of England Grammar in Brisbane in 1967. He made recorded admissions to Police and myself. He was charged and committed to Trial. The Anglican Church paid me about \$10K, this was the figure I was given as the cost of defending compensation which I could not win as I was out of time. Hiding behind legals and insurers. Thenm there was a confidentiality clause to accept the \$10K.

Suggestions:

1. Confidentiality clauses be legally revoked.
2. Compensation be legally able to be reopened.
3. That buildings named after people such as Headmaster's in schools when abuse happened under thier watch be renamed. For example the long standing Headmaster at Church of England Grammar in Brisbane was Harry Roberts. It was during his watch most of the Churchie abuse happened. The schools most glamorous building is named after him "the Roberts Centre". This and others around the country need renaming.
4. School uniforms need changing and school colours need changing to firstly acknowledge abuse and change, and secondly to not be "in your face". I still cringe almost 50 years later when I see the uniform of Church of England Grammar in Brisbane where I live. I have spoken to another Church of England Grammar in Brisbane victim who moved cities to escape the visual impact of the uniform (no other reason).

I am happy to expand on these.
